Directions: *From Salisbury:* Take Rt. 12 E toward Snow Hill. Turn right onto Nassawango Rd. Turn left onto River Rd, which leads you to **Milburn Landing (western part of the Pocomoke River State Park)**. Follow the signs toward Nassawango pavilion. Park your car at the pavilion parking lot. We will meet at the playground next to the pavilion.

*From Berlin:* Take Rt. 113 S to Snow Hill. Turn right onto Rt. 113 BUS into downtown Snow Hill. Turn right on Rt. 12 W, then turn left on Nassawango Rd. Turn left onto River Rd, which leads you to **Milburn Landing (part of the Pocomoke River State Park)**. Follow the signs toward Nassawango pavilion. Park your car at the pavilion parking lot. We will meet at the playground next to the pavilion.

**Note: Milburn Landing can not be accessed from Shad Landing!**
