Christmas Parade workshop: Saturday, December 2nd from 10 am to 11:30 am at the ACT office on 9842 N Main Street in Berlin

Christmas Parade: Thursday, December 7th at 7 pm (rain date 12/14/2017). Please come at 6:30 pm to the line-up on Tripoli Street. The parade route has been changed this year. It'll go from the Welcome Center on Main Street to the Berlin Fire Company. We will be #23 in the line-up, so you can expect to finish the parade at about 8 pm.

This year's theme of the Christmas Parade is "Peace on Earth". The Coast Kids float will be a reef with fish, octopus, crabs and all sorts of other reef critters. At the workshop we will construct the reef and individual smaller critters to take home. **If you would like to participate in the Berlin Christmas Parade on December 7th, please come to the workshop, and make a critter for you to display in the parade. From Salisbury: Take Rt. 50 E. Turn right on Main Street toward Berlin. The ACT office is on the left side.

From Snow Hill/Pocomoke City: Take Rt. 113 N. At the Food Lion in Berlin turn left onto Old Ocean City Blvd. Then turn right onto N Main Street. The office is on your right.
