Directions: *From Berlin/OC:* Go on Rt. 113 S toward Snow Hill. Shortly after passing Snow Hill, turn right toward Pocomoke River State Park. Pass the entrance booth (there is no charge), and turn the first right. Then turn left toward the Nature Center.

*From Salisbury:* Go on Rt. 12 E toward Snow Hill. At the stoplight in Snow Hill turn right onto Rt. 113 BUS/W Market Street. Merge onto Rt. 113 S toward Pocomoke City. About 1 mile later turn right toward Pocomoke River State Park. Pass the entrance booth (there is no charge), and turn the first right. Then turn left toward the Nature Center.
