Eastern Bluebirds are beautiful small birds that live on insects and berries. They build their nests either in old woodpecker holes or use nesting boxes. Directions: From Berlin (downtown): Go on 113 N. Shortly after crossing Rt. 50 take the exit to Worcester Highway. Red Doors Community Center is located directly after the Rt. 90 underpass on the left.

From Salisbury: Take Rt 50 E, then turn onto Rt. 90 E. Turn onto Rt 113 N, then take the next exit to Worcester Highway. Turn right onto Worcester Highway. Red Doors Community Center is located on the right directly in front of the Rt. 90 underpass.
