Frogs communicate by calling to each other. Some can make quite loud sounds. Amphibians often hide very well, so the best way to identify the species present is to listen to their specific calls. Join us and learn about amphibian life, behavior, and how to distinguish species by their sounds. This event is in the evening, because frogs are most active at night. Please bring bug spray.

Directions: *From Salisbury:* Go east on Rt. 50 E toward Berlin. Turn right onto Old Ocean City Blvd (Rt. 346). Cross Main Street. Berlin Falls Park is on your left shortly after you cross the train tracks.

From Ocean City: Do west on Rt. 50 W toward Berlin. Turn left onto Old Ocean City Blvd (Rt. 346) and cross Rt. 113. Berlin Falls Park is on your right across from the Burley Oak Brewing Company.
