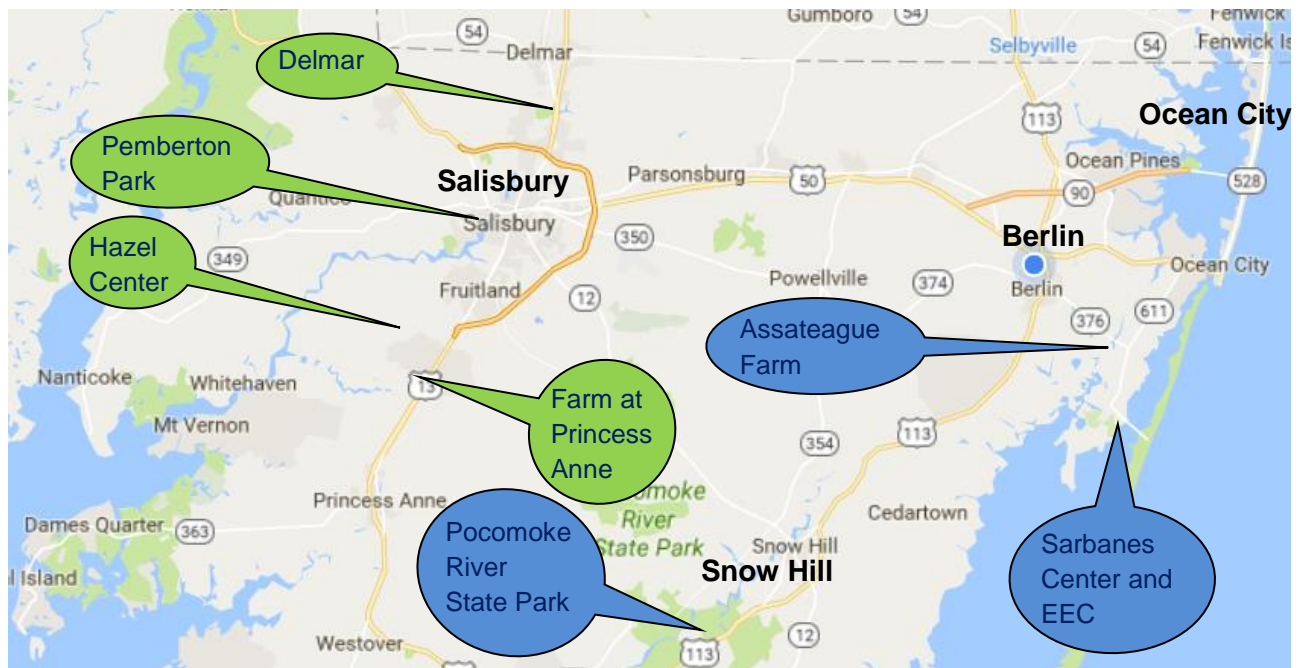
Week 1: Monday, June 18 to Thursday, June 21 from 10 AM to 2:30 PM
