Directions: *From Salisbury:* Take Rt. 12 E toward Snow Hill. Immediately after the drawbridge in Snow Hill turn left and park at the **Pocomoke River Canoe Company**.

From Berlin: Take Rt. 113 S, turn right onto Rt. 113 BUS toward downtown Snow Hill. At the traffic light turn right onto Rt. 12 W. The **Pocomoke River Canoe Company** is on your right just before the drawbridge.
