The bay is very shallow and warm. Please wear your bathing suit and water shoes, and bring a towel, sunscreen and bug spray. It might be nice to bring a bagged lunch and enjoy the rest of the day on the freshly cleaned-up beach.

Leave a message with your name, phone number, and number of participating kids, so that we know how many art supplies to bring. The event is free for members and non-members.**

Directions: *From Salisbury:* Take Rt. 50 E, then turn right onto Rt. 113 S. Take a left onto Rt. 376 E following the signs towards Assateague Parks. Turn right onto Rt. 611 S, drive over the bridge to Assateague, and take the first right towards **Assateague National Seashore. September 28 is a fee free day.** After you pass the entrance booth turn right onto Bayside Drive towards the Bayside campground and canoe rental. We meet at the picnic area at the end of Bayside Dr.

From Ocean City: Cross the Rt. 50 bridge, and turn left onto Rt. 611 S. Then drive over the bridge to Assateague and take the first right towards **Assateague National Seashore. September 28 is a fee free day.** After you pass the entrance booth turn right onto Bayside Drive towards the Bayside campground and canoe rental. We meet at the picnic area at the end of Bayside Dr.
