Frog Calls at the Rackliffe House Trail

Frogs communicate by calling to each other. In some places you can hear a whole frog concert on warm spring evenings. Amphibians often hide very well, so the best way to identify the species



present is to listen to their specific calls. Join us and learn about amphibian life, behavior, and how to distinguish species by their sounds. This event is in the evening because frogs are most active at night. Please be prepared to walk about a mile, and wear shoes that may get wet. Also, please bring bug spray.

<u>Directions</u>: *From Salisbury:* Go on Rt. 50 E, then turn right onto Rt. 113 S. At the second light turn left onto Assateague Rd (Rt. 376). Turn right onto Rt. 611 S. Just before crossing the bridge to Assateague Island, turn right onto Marsh View Lane and park in the parking lot at the Assateague Island National Seashore Visitor Center.

From Downtown Berlin: Cross Rt. 113 from Bay Street onto Assateague Rd (Rt. 376). Turn right onto Rt. 611 S. Just before crossing the bridge to Assateague Island, turn right onto Marsh View Lane and park in the parking lot at the Assateague Island National Seashore Visitor Center.

From Ocean City: Take Rt. 50 W, then turn onto Rt. 113 S. Just before crossing the bridge to Assateague Island, turn right onto Marsh View Lane and park in the parking lot at the Assateague Island National Seashore Visitor Center.
