

Tree Rings – What Tree Rings Can Tell Us About a Plant’s Life



Tree rings tell a story about a tree’s life. They reveal not only the number of years a tree lived but provide answers to more questions: How much light and nutrients did a tree access during different phases of its life? Was it injured or infested with insects? What were the surrounding conditions? Students closely examine cross sections of tree trunks. Grade 2 to 5 students also study the vascular system of plants through digital microscopes.
