### Living Shoreline and Kite Building at the Assateague State Park Boat Ramp

Date: **Saturday, July 6, 2024**

Time: **9:30 AM to 11 AM**

Meeting point: **Trail head at the Assateague State Park boat ramp parking lot**

Address: **Near 7200 Stephen Decatur Hwy, Berlin, MD.** (Left side of Rt. 611 just before crossing the bridge to Assateague Island.)

Parking Passes: **Free parking passes will be provided for registered event participants.**



In 2018, the eroding marsh at the Assateague State Park boat ramp area was reconstructed to serve as a better habitat for bay life. Now the shoreline has a scalloped shape protected by some big boulders, rocks, gravel, and lots of native grasses. Let's see what kind of creatures we can find along the shore! Wear water shoes or old sneakers (no flip flops). Please bring a bathing suit, towel, sunscreen, and bug spray. After exploring the bay, we will also build, decorate, and fly kites.

Directions: *From Salisbury:* Go on Rt. 50 E, then turn right onto Rt. 113 S. At the second light turn left onto Assateague Rd (Rt. 376). Turn right onto Rt. 611 S. Just before crossing the bridge to Assateague Island, turn left into the parking lot of Assateague State Park boat ramp/marina.

*From Downtown Berlin:* Cross Rt. 113 from Bay Street onto Assateague Rd (Rt. 376). Turn right onto Rt. 611 S. Just before crossing the bridge to Assateague Island, turn left into the parking lot of Assateague State Park boat ramp/marina.

*From Ocean City:* Take Rt. 50 W, then turn onto Rt. 113 S. Just before crossing the bridge to Assateague Island, turn left into the parking lot of Assateague State Park boat ramp/marina.
