see lots of crabs, and maybe some other sea creatures as well. We will provide bait, crab lines, and nets as well as life vests for those who need them. The pier has a small slide into the water and makes a great place to cool off and have fun in the bay. Please bring a bathing suit, towel, and water shoes (the bay is shallow enough for bigger kids to stand up), sunscreen and bug spray. Public Landing has also a shady pavilion with tables at the pier for a picnic.

<u>Directions</u>: From Berlin/OC: Take Rt. 113 S towards Snow Hill. Turn left onto Public Landing Road (Rt. 365) to Public Landing. The road ends at the boat landing and public pier.

From Salisbury: Take Rt. 12 to Snow Hill. At the red light in town turn left onto E Market Street, then take the second right onto Bay Street (Rt. 365), which becomes Public Landing Rd. Go across Rt. 113 and follow the road to the boat ramp and public pier.
