Ornithologist (bird specialist) Professor Tami Ransom will show us how she uses mist nets to capture songbirds, and how to measure and mark them with ankle bands. Banding birds helps scientists to understand how many birds of a species are in an area, and where and when birds migrate. This is a great

opportunity to see birds up close! We will also do a class about bird adaptations, and a bird craft.

From Snow Hill: Take Rt 12 W to Salisbury. Turn left onto E College Ave. Turn left onto Camden Ave.
