

Water Quality Testing and Crabbing at Public Landing Pier

Come and learn real-life scientific methods to test the bay's water quality. Then spend some time at the beautiful Public Landing pier on Chincoteague Bay to catch crabs and go swimming. We hope to see lots of crabs, and maybe some other sea creatures as well. We will provide bait, crab lines, and nets as well as life vests for those who need them. There is a small slide into the water. Please bring a bathing suit, towel, and water shoes (the bay is shallow enough for bigger kids



to stand up), sunscreen and bug spray. In case the CDC recommends mask wearing at the time of the event, please bring a mask. There is a shelter with tables at the pier which makes it a great place for a picnic.

Number of spaces available: Limit 25 kids. Please sign up for the event at www.actforbays.org/coastkids, or by calling the Assateague Coastal Trust office at 410-629-1538. Leave a message with your name, phone number, and number of participating kids. The event is free for members and costs \$3 for nonmembers.

Directions: From Berlin/OC: Take Rt. 113 S towards Snow Hill. Turn left onto Public Landing Road (Rt. 365) to Public Landing. The road ends at the boat landing and public pier.

From Salisbury: Take Rt, 12 to Snow Hill. At the red light in town turn left onto E Market Street, then take the second right onto Bay Street (Rt. 365), which becomes Public Landing Rd. Cross Rt. 113 until you reach the boat ramp and public pier.
