Paddling on Ayers Creek is a great outdoor adventure! You might see herons stalking fish, turtles basking in the sun, or crabs scurrying along the river bottom.

The launch area is a smooth riverbank which makes it

easy to climb in and out of the paddleboats. We will provide kayaks, a canoe, and life vests. No paddling experience is needed. Please wear water shoes and clothes that may get wet (water dripping off paddles!) and bring bug spray, sunscreen, a hat, and water.

Directions: *From Berlin:* Take Rt 376 (Assateague Rd) toward Rt 611. Turn left on Rt 611 toward OC, then turn the first left onto Lewes Rd. At 8913 Lewis Rd, turn left onto the gated dirt lane. The parking area is at the end of the lane.

*From Ocean City:* Go south on Rt. 611. Turn right onto Lewes Rd. At 8913 Lewis Rd, turn left onto the gated dirt lane. The parking area is at the end of the lane.

*From Salisbury:* Take Rt 50 E to Berlin. Exit onto Rt 113 S toward Snow Hill. Turn left onto Rt 376 (Assateague Rd) toward Assateague Parks. Turn left on Rt 611 toward OC, then turn the first left onto Lewes Rd. At 8913 Lewis Rd, turn left onto the gated dirt lane. The parking area is at the end of the lane.
