



### **Pond Critters at Lizard Hill**

The Lizard Hill vegetation used to be destroyed by a sand mining operation. After the mine was abandoned, the area was restored with Atlantic White Cedar trees. Now, lots of birds, mammals, reptiles, amphibians, and freshwater critters made the shallow ponds, the stream, and the woods on

Lizard Hill their home.

We will learn about the restoration project, the animals that thrive at Lizard Hill, and catch macroinvertebrates (small freshwater critters). **Please wear closed-toed shoes that can get wet, and bring bug spray and sunscreen.**

Directions:

*From Berlin and Snow Hill:* Take Rt 113 N toward Dover. Turn right onto Bishopville Rd. Shortly after you cross the bridge in Bishopville, turn left onto Hatchery Rd. Then turn left onto Cemetery Rd. Lizard Hill is located at the end of Cemetery Rd.

*From Ocean City:* Take Rt 90 W toward Salisbury. On the Isle of Wight turn left onto St. Martins Neck Rd. Exit onto Rt 113 N toward Dover. Turn right onto Bishopville Rd. Turn left onto Hatchery Rd. Then turn left onto Cemetery Rd. Lizard Hill is located at the end of Cemetery Rd.

*From Salisbury:* Take Rt 50 E, then Rt 90 E toward Ocean City. Exit onto Rt 113 N toward Dover. Turn right onto Bishopville Rd. Shortly after you cross the bridge in Bishopville, turn left onto Hatchery Rd. Then turn left onto Cemetery Rd. Lizard Hill is located at the end of Cemetery Rd.
