

Owls – All About These Specialized Predators



Students study Eastern Shore owl species, their special adaptations, and an owl's diet and food chain. The dissection of sterilized owl pellets reveals what owls have been consuming. It also invites students to learn about small mammal skeletons. Students who are not comfortable dissecting a real owl pellet may use an artificial substitute.

Grade level: 1st to 6th grade
