The launch area is a boat ramp which makes it easy to climb in and out of the paddleboats. We will provide kayaks, a canoe, and life vests. No paddling experience is needed. Please wear clothes that may get wet (water dripping from paddles!) and bring bug spray, sunscreen, hat, and water.

From Snow Hill/Pocomoke City: Drive north on Rt. 113 towards Newark. Turn right onto Langmaid Rd, then left onto Marshall Creek Rd. The boat ramp is at the end of Marshall Creek Rd.
